

**DIRECTIONS:**

- **FOR WATERING LAWNS AND FAIRWAYS:** Add or inject 1-4 pints per 1,000 sq. Feet in 10-15 gallons of water.
- **GREENS, THATCHED AND COMPACTED AREAS:** Add or inject 1 quart per 1,000 sq. Feet in 10-15 gallons of water.
- **FOR INHIBITION OF DEW FORMATION:** Apply 5 pints in 100 gallons of water to 25,000 sq. feet. Single application can be expected to inhibit dew formation for 2-4 days.
- **FOR AIDING THE SPREADING OF PESTICIDES:** Fungicides and insecticides: Add 1-5 pints per 100 gallons of spray solution. Herbicides: Add 5-10 pints per 100 gallons of spray solution.
- Dilutions may vary with different methods of application. Use only enough to help penetration. Excessive rates will evidence themselves in excessive foaming and runoff.

Spray adjuvant is a professional-grade concentrate surfactant mixture. It is designed primarily as a soil penetrant to increase watering efficiency and generate deep root systems on lawns, turf and fairways. It is also excellent as a spreading agent to enhance coverage and wetting action of solutions of herbicides, fungicides and insecticides.

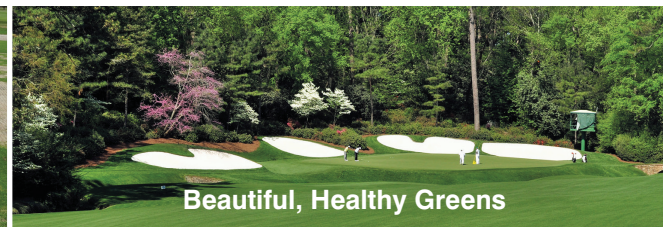
