DIRECTIONS:

- For heavy cleaning and degreasing of road equipment undercarriages and tractors, cranes and 5th wheels: Dilution Ratio — 20 to 1
- For regular cleaning of equipment, trucks, machinery and road equipment: Dilution Ratio — 30 to 1
- For best results, apply product using its recommended dilutions, from bottom and up, allowing solution to remain 3-5 minutes before rinsing.
- For heavily encrusted equipment, repeat same procedure if needed.

HEALTH HAZARD DATA, EFFECTS OF OVEREXPOSURE, FIRST AID:
